Finding Hope Through Education: Elizabeth's Story



Elizabeth and her family live in a remote village of Kagan, along the shores of Lake Victoria. When Elizabeth was about 1 year old, her Dad passed away, leaving her mother as a widow with three young children. Not too long after, Elizabeth's Mother became disabled and as a result, their family faced immense challenges throughout her early childhood years.

When Elizabeth first came to **Shelter of Hope Academy**, she didn't trust that she was *safe* or was in a place that would provide for her, beyond education. (Continue on page 2).

The Last 3 Months At Shelter of Hope (SOH)

- We were able to provide nutritious food to the most vulnerable students at SOH.
- The resumption of learning activities in both Shelter of Hope Academy locations (Nairobi & Kagan).
- Proper safety regulations and equipment needed for all of the staff and students of both locations were provided. Classes were able to resume safely because of this!
- Graduation ceremonies were able to take place in both locations. Families were able to attend safely!
- We were able to safely hold Youth events.
- An opportunity for a free medical camp in Kagan for students was available this past summer.


Elizabeth's Story Cont'd
