"Most of the children come broken and confused to the home and as we navigate their uniqueness, we always find that the one thing they all come with is the ability to love and be loved!" Tat's Kids enables children to go through Christian care and mentoring amidst a highly sexualized culture.



Currently, there are 12 children under their care and two of the girls, Liliana and Lucy, came to know Christ and were baptized on November 1st!



THE POWER OF EDUCATION & LEADERSHIP TRAINING

At ImpactHope, we believe that **education** is an important and powerful tool for breaking the cycle of poverty and investing in it it bridges the gap in social inequality. We understand that food and education work in tandem, as hunger keeps children out of school and hinders their learning. When a child is fed, their ability to learn is vastly improved!

In today's world, **leadership** is critical and sadly challenged by multiple factors such as a lack of resources, training, and family finances. We know that leadership is critical to the success of the initiatives that address poverty and therefore, we support efforts that develop well-trained Christian community leaders who can make an impact on their communities.

SHELTER OF HOPE ACADEMY (KENYA)

Our workers, Ishmael and Molline, began ministering in a slum in Nairobi by tutoring, educating, and feeding a few children and their early efforts produced a charity called Shelter of Hope. Following the inception of a school, they started the Shelter of Hope Academy and other programs (a health clinic, agriculture, women empowerment – to name a few). In 2011, they created Vision Ministries Kenya, a network of over 40 churches focusing on church planting, pastoral training, and leadership development.

MOVING FORWARD

Both the Nairobi and Kagan locations of the Shelter of Hope Academy began a new academic year on a high note in July this year! With a joint student population of 450, both schools have completed opening examinations and the results were incredible. A good number of staff have been vaccinated for Covid-19 and the schools continue to comply with Covid-19 protocols.

MORE THAN JUST BOOKS

Time and time again, we have encountered financial, mental, and social distress in children caused by poverty. Following the pandemic, 12-year-old Kerubo's parents lost their jobs as casual labourers. The inability to pay the fees or to attend school added to her psychological trauma. The SOH management stepped in and waived Kerubo's fees.

This enabled her to return to school and attend counselling at the Shelter Academy counselling club, where counselling is carried out weekly for traumatized children. Kerubo has recovered emotionally and is motivated, like the many other children blessed by the SOH Academy.

PRAYER POINTS FOR SOH

Students are excited to learn but exhausted by the multitude of challenges that they have faced. We need your prayers for those who are in dire need of COVID-19 protective items. Fundraising needs include:

- Teachers' salaries, and food for staff and students
- Completion of Kagan school infrastructure (8 classrooms and solar backup system)
- Building of the Kiambiu-Nairobi school.
- Completion of the solar-powered water system for the rural school.



EDUCATION IN FORT JACQUES (HAITI)

This year has not been without its difficulties, but with God's help and Haitian 'degaje' methods, we were able to have a positive year. **Degaje** means to do what you need to do with what you have. This community is a powerful testament to the strength given by God to overcome adversity!

We overcame unfinished walls by using rocks to hold down papers, and wear sweaters when it is cloudy, cold and windy. We use low voices in classrooms as separating, walls are still unbuilt. When teachers fall sick... (read more on pg 3)

"Bonjour! M'rele Jean. I am three years old. I live in Fort Jacques, Haiti. You have made a big difference in my life! I want to thank you for helping me to go to school. I do not have anything to play with at my little house, so I run to school every morning because I want to play with the toys there. I feel loved by my teacher and she's taught me how to hold a pencil. I can almost print my name, all by myself. I am also learning how to pray every morning. School is so much fun! EDUCATION IN HUEHUETENANGO (GUATEMALA)

30 years ago, the education system in the remote areas near Huehuetenango, Guatemala was in disarray due to the lack of available schools in remote areas. Sadly, many children stayed home, quit school, and found low-paying jobs. Without education, there was little hope of improving their circumstances and life.

ImpactHope has been partnering with Gilberto and Ruth Noriega for over 25 years and we have assisted them in the construction of **14 in 28** schools! The majority of these schools are now fully sustainable. Funding through ImpactHope is provided for families who may otherwise be unable to afford the tuition costs. We truly believe that any investment that donors provide will impact future generations, villages, and the nation!

DESK FUNDRAISER

Back in August, we asked if you would help us purchase 400 desks for two schools in Huehuetenango and we are thrilled to share that **you've helped us buy 93 desks so far!** The children and teachers at Fuente de Amor school in Buenos Aires Chantla thank you!

The Grace Project International (TGPI) is focused on training pastors, who are called to serve but encounter educational and financial challenges which prevent them from attending established Bible colleges and seminaries.

SOLAR LIGHT FUNDRAISER

One of the greatest needs in Zambia is the need for adequate lighting. Several schools are not connected to the National Power Grid and therefore have power instability.

Our goal for 2022 is to purchase at least 7 solar-powered lights and 7 rechargeable lights to help students study more efficiently.

THE HOSPITAL IS TAKING SHAPE (NEBAJ)

Dr. Juan Pablo, Carolina, and their medical team continue to provide quality healthcare to the community of Nebaj. With the help of teams and the support of our donors, the pouring of cement on the first and second floor of the new hospital was finished by the end of February 2020 and the first floor of the hospital started taking shape by the end of 2020. Now, it is almost finished but we need your help to complete it!

Jose was having a difficult time with undiagnosed abdominal pain, in spite of being investigated for an entire day! By God's grace, he was sent to Servicios Medicos Vida y Esperanza, which has premier ultrasound technology, thanks to our generous donors. He was finally given a proper life-saving diagnosis of acute appendicitis!

The Kenya Economic Development Human Advancement Project (KEDHAP) is the development, peace-building, and relief arm of the Kenya Mennonite Church in the Diocese of Kisumu East. From its humble beginnings in the year 2000, KEDHAP has steadily grown and now serves thousands of participants through a wide range of programs, in extremely poor rural areas.

Some of KEDHAP's major work is in the areas of Female Empowerment, Education, Community Development, Health Education, Peacemaking & Reconciliation, Food Security & Income Generation, and Leadership Development. A powerful project is **KEDHAP's assistance to People living with HIV and AIDS**, wherein KEDHAP provides food for those who are unable to work or grow food; and seeds and other materials for those who can grow their own food.

HOPE FOR AN HIV-POSITIVE CHILD: JOEL'S STORY



Joel (on the right), his mother (on the left) and two siblings.

Joel is an HIV-positive 15-year-old boy who studies at a Primary School in Kenya. Optimum nutrition is a critical component of comprehensive prevention, care, and treatment in individuals with HIV and AIDS. In spite of poverty and the lack of food, Joel had to be consistent with his medication, which made him susceptible to weakness, and caused him to miss school. KEDHAP became Joel's saving grace as it supplied him with maize for nutrition, and transport money to visit the hospital and receive timely medication. Joel is grateful for the financial and nutritional support and he hopes to take his KCPE exams the following year. Joel hopes to continue his education and he needs further support to make his dreams come true!

Gustovito is a precious little 6-year-old with a 4-year-old younger brother named Jimmy. Their story is heartbreaking and sadly, is not uncommon for children in Iquitos. Gustovito's mother is a drug addict who's unable to care for the boys. Their grandmother who took them in is now too old to continue providing for them. Gustovito and Jimmy are now living in an orphanage in Iquitos. Unfortunately, the city orphanage has been operating at 20% above capacity for several years, and therefore, the importance of Hogar Genesis is evident. Gustovito and Jimmy will be taken in by Hogar

Genesis when it opens! Since their mother is still alive, there is hope to restore the family unit through the Christian counsel provided by Hogar Genesis. You can give Gustovito a home and hope!

FOOD SECURITY & ACCESS TO CLEAN WATER

Good nutrition and safe drinking water are fundamental to the health and dignity of all. Without sustainable food and clean water, families and communities will continue to struggle in poverty. The availability of healthy food and clean water brings better health, hygiene, and sanitation. As a result, the community can flourish and a reliable source of clean water can allow for the planning of agricultural initiatives.

KENYA WATER WELL

Working alongside Vision Ministries Kenya (a network of 40 churches), we are committed to supporting families in Kenya who live in extreme poverty.

In 2019, ImpactHope committed to drilling a well in the Olkesumet Prayer Response Center. The first attempt to drill was not successful, but we didn't give up! The Maasai people had been praying for water for many years. They were very discouraged when the first attempt of drilling failed. At the second attempt this year, a bountiful supply of clean fresh water was located at a depth of 300m! There is a large quantity of water, and **it will impact over 400 people** in a 5 km area. The people are overwhelmed with happiness and gratitude, for this well is a major blessing in their community.



HELP US COMPLETE THE WELL!

Sufficient funding has been received to drill the borehole which is now capped. More funding is needed to purchase a Pump, Water Tower, and more. We are praying for \$25,000 to move this project to the next phase! The overall vision is to increase sustainability within the community and create opportunities for income and growth!

CUBA FOOD PROGRAMS

Food is becoming scarce and prices are increasing drastically as covid continues to spread within the island. Before the economic recession, 1 lb of meat was \$1 USD and 5 lbs of rice was \$1 USD. Now, 1 lb of meat is about \$5 USD and 1 lb of rice is now \$3 USD. With your help, several families were blessed with food during the last 4 months.

As of September 2021, KEDHAP supplies sanitary pads and underwear and **provides counseling for 5,525 young girls from 52 schools, coming from economically deprived households.** An increasing number of girls now go on to finish secondary school, avoid early marriage and keep their dreams of a better future alive!

"I used to tell teachers that I am sick so they would give me permission to stay home for the four days I was on my period. This made me fall behind in school and when I got my exam results back, they were not good. When I did try to go to school during my period, I would lose focus because I thought I may have ruined my uniform. Now, thanks to KEDHAP's sanitary pad program, I can go to school, even during my period, and not worry. I am happy and relieved." - Brenda

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

ImpactHope seeks to address issues of gender equality, just as Jesus lived a life without prejudice, treating all men and women equal. Gender inequality is truly a global concern and it is our goal to support and develop programs that address gender-based violence, access to quality healthcare for women, equal access to quality education for girls, child marriage, as well as skills training, and business opportunities for women!

We are seeking to expand our present initiatives that empower girls and women such as providing sanitary pads for girls through secondary school, enabling them to complete their education, and giving them the opportunity to pursue future studies. We also support microfinancing projects, sewing initiatives, and support groups for both women and girls.

Brenda is in her fourth year at a Secondary School in Muhoroni and lives in the slums with a widowed mother and 3 younger siblings. Her mother could not afford to put her through school, let alone buy her sanitary pads. **Brenda is now 1 of the 315 girls from her school that KEDHAP supports with sanitary pads and panties and now she doesn't need to miss school anymore, simply being a girl!**

KEEPING GIRLS IN SCHOOL (KENYA)

The main goal of KEDHAP's Female Empowerment Ministry is to empower widows, orphans, and other vulnerable people through avenues such as education. The activities leading towards the achievement of the education goal are:

- To provide access to secondary education for economically disadvantaged students, especially girls and orphans;
