GREAT NEWS! SOH Academy Scores a Rank!

GREAT NEWS! Shelter of Hope (SOH) academy in Kagan, Kenya, has done exceptionally well in the national exams this year! With every gift you have given, you have further cemented their future.

Kenya has grade 8 national exams every year. Shelter of Hope (SOH) academy in Kagan goes up to grade 8, and the school in Nairobi goes up to grade 7. The grade 8 class ranked 2nd out of 210 schools in Rangwe County (a sub-county of Homabay Country), where SOH academy is situated. These children have worked so hard to pass their national exams, but sadly they do not have the resources to continue this successful journey. With YOUR help, they can resume their education and continue to empower themselves!





Why are higher grades important in National Testing? Higher grades allow children to enroll in higher quality secondary schools, thereby enhancing their chances of achieving their aspirations.

The Last 3 Months At Shelter of Hope (SOH)

- Community Relief: From March 22nd to 26th, SOH reached out to children, women, and the elderly in West Pokot.
 Sanitary towels, clothes, and food were distributed to the recipients. The gospel was shared with the community.
- Women's Conference: A women's conference was hosted for over 200+ ladies in April. Around 700 people attended the daily meetings, out of which 48 people received Baptism.
- The Nairobi school helped students transition to their higher grades in March. Students enjoyed a month-long break and came back to school.
- The school now runs classes from Kindergarten to Grade 7 (Pre-candidate class).
- A talent show was held for the students. It was an excellent opportunity for students to build confidence and a joy to see the little ones showcase their gifts.
