It was late at night and I was responsible for my team of volunteers who traveled from Canada to ImpactHope's project site in Iquitos, Peru. As we got into motor cars to head over to the drug hole, I started feeling a mix of excitement and fear. Little did I know, this would be one of the most memorable and emotional nights out of all my trips to Iquitos.

I met a little boy that night. A boy who barely spoke but his love and affection spoke louder than words could ever speak. As someone who lost their father at a young age, I connected deeply with this child. Whenever you feel alone, know that you are loved, cared for, and seen. You are never alone."

As I spent more time with this little boy, I saw his demeanor change. This was hope. He jumped into my arms and gave me the biggest hug. I could not stop crying as I went back to Hogar Genesis that night – I too felt the impact of hope. With every trip I make to Iquitos, I grow a stronger connection with the community and a sense of belonging. This connection has changed my life and it continues to encourage me. I hope it continues to encourage them too.
