Hospital:

- Over 6.7% of patients in 2022 received free healthcare because they could not afford medical costs.
- Brian shot a short documentary about the project during his time there.
 This powerful and profoundly moving work highlights the project's history and impact on the Nebaj community.
- We are elated to have conducted THE HOUR with Dr. Juan Pablo and his wife, Carolina, on December 07, 2022.
- Three teams travelled to Nebaj from Ontario. Besides helping with construction projects, the teams accompany a local pastor on house visits in the community. Much construction work has been completed for the first and second floors.





Other Ministry: The team is supporting projects that offer sustainable solutions to the community:

- Men's Support Group The Maverick Men's Support Group gives men from different churches a safe space to pray for each other, have communion and discuss relatable issues.
- Spiritual Mentoring Pastor Noé Martínez conducts bible studies and offers spiritual counselling to hospital staff.
- Pastor Noe sometimes prays with patients waiting for a consultation with their doctor. He offers spiritual counselling to patients struggling to come to terms with their diagnosis.
