### ABOUT THE PROJECT

In Nebaj, Guatemala, our partners Juan Pablo and Carolina are involved in multiple initiatives to provide and improve current healthcare efforts to vulnerable people in their community. Since 2015, ImpactHope has been involved in the ongoing construction of a hospital, which is open to serve patients! Servicios Medicos Vida y Esperanza, or Medical Services for Life and Hope, currently offers various medical and dental services to their community including medical consultations, a clinical laboratory, care for the bedridden, ultrasounds and X-ray services, food assistance for low-income families, education for workers' children, and activities in the Cristo Salva church.

### TRIP DESCRIPTION

Join us on a journey to Nebaj and help empower communities to overcome poverty! Through our partnership with Juan Pablo and Carolina, we'll have the chance to engage in various initiatives that align with our values and goals, including, improving access to healthcare, building relationships, and providing aid and assistance where it's needed most. Much of this trip will be focused on construction initiatives for the hospital, as well as home visits within the community. This trip promises to be a life-changing experience, both for the people you'll be helping and for yourself! As our team develops, other opportunities to serve the community will be considered as we review the skills and gifts of our team!

### DETAILS

<b>DATES</b> FEB 8-19 2024	The duration of this trip will be 12 days in total. This includes 2 travel days, and 1 excursion day at the end of the trip. The rest of the trip will be spent in Nebaj! Please note that these dates may change.
<b>COST</b> \$3975	The cost of this trip includes flights, accommodation, food, transportation, and administrative costs! This cost also includes the participants portion of the construction costs - any additional expenses during travel or excursion days are not included in the cost. <u>This cost is an estimate based on 15 ppl and may change due to several factors.</u>
