
Every donation, no matter the size, is part of a bigger story of love and transformation. Thank you for being part of the ImpactHope family and for making hope a reality for people around the world!

Mercy's early life was marked by hardship. With no father in her life and a mother struggling with mental health, Mercy wandered the streets of Kisumu. Her future looked uncertain—until a compassionate woman on the outskirts of Kisumu took her in, giving her a home and a glimmer of hope. Despite being born with HIV, Mercy remained resilient and positive, until tragedy struck again in 2021 with the passing of her beloved foster mother.

At her lowest point, Mercy found refuge at the Ogen Clinic, where Sister Susan, a dedicated nurse supporting HIV/AIDS patients, welcomed her into her own family. This act of kindness became a turning point, offering her the love and stability she desperately needed.

KEDHAP Foundation has transformed Mercy's life. Their Secondary School Scholarship not only kept her in school but boosted her academic performance from a C- to a C+.

Today, she's thriving as a Form Two student and an active member of the Ogen CCC HIV+ adolescents' group. With her dream of becoming a nurse now within reach, Mercy's journey is a testament to KEDHAP's life-changing impact. (impacthope.ca/KEDHAP)

GIVE THE GIFT OF EDUCATION & LEADERSHIP TRAINING

Jocelyn dreams of becoming a mason one day.

But like so many other children, his dreams are at risk. Over 265 million children worldwide are currently out of school: without education, their dreams may never come true. Education is the key to breaking the cycle of poverty, empowering children like him not only to survive but thrive.



Education is a gateway to hope in Haiti, Kenya, Guatemala, Peru and Malawi. Your gift can provide school supplies, uniforms, and scholarships, opening doors to opportunities for children who otherwise might not have access to schooling.


Among the students in Fort Jacques,

IMPACT STORY: HEALING & HOPE IN PERU

Hogar Genesis, led by Rodolfo in Iquitos, Peru, is more than a safe haven for vulnerable children—it's a beacon of hope for the community. In addition to caring for 17 children at the home, Rodolfo and his team serve in the slums of Belen through the Belen Kids ministry, offering education, food, and love to children living in extreme poverty.

Fernanda arrived at Hogar Génesis as a tiny three-month-old baby, born into a life of immense challenges. Her parents, both drug addicts living with HIV, were unable to care for her, and initial tests confirmed that Fernanda had also contracted HIV. But amidst this heartbreaking situation, Hogar Génesis became her safe haven.

Fast forward to March 2023, and we celebrated a miracle! After months of care, love, and prayer, Fernanda was re-tested, and the results were nothing short of amazing: she has been declared 100% free from HIV! Rodolfo and the dedicated team at Hogar Génesis have poured their hearts into caring for Fernanda and the other children in the home, providing not only for their physical needs but also nurturing their mental and spiritual well-being. After a thorough diagnosis, the team discovered she was suffering from a life-threatening autoimmune condition. IMPACT STORY: FROM DROUGHT TO HARVEST

In the heart of the Maasai community in Kenya, where the dry and unforgiving terrain once offered little promise of sustenance, hope now springs forth in abundance. Thanks to the recent installation of a community borehole, this arid landscape has been transformed into a thriving oasis, breathing new life into the people and the land.

The journey to this transformation began with a simple yet profound goal: to provide access to clean water for the Maasai people. Prior to the well, women and children trekked up to 10 kilometers daily, often returning with contaminated water.

Today, the story is entirely different. The well has changed the rhythm of life in the village, providing clean water not just for drinking but for irrigation and livestock as well. Crops now flourish in fields that were once barren, and families have a newfound sense of stability. Women, once bound by the daily search for water, now have time to pursue entrepreneurial ventures, while children—especially girls—can attend school regularly, with no fear of falling behind.
