This kind of flexible support is especially vital through our **ImpactHope Operations Campaign**. It's not just about keeping the lights on—it's about building the infrastructure that makes everything else possible. From coordinating international teams to ensuring funds are transferred smoothly to our partners on the ground, to launching new initiatives and strengthening existing ones—this campaign empowers us to send more resources, more support, and more hope exactly where it's needed.

The following project highlights are a glimpse into what you made happen.

### Madagascar – Seeds of Sustainability 🌱🌱

In Madagascar, local farmers are equipped with sustainable, climate-sensitive agricultural methods through the “Foundations for Farming” model. This project is addressing critical food insecurity by training leaders who, in turn, train others—creating a ripple effect across communities. Already, rice yields have increased from a national average of 1.5 tons per hectare to over 6 tons in some of our project sites, proving the model's effectiveness. With strong support from government leaders and local partners, and the launch of our Sponsor a Farmer program, we are laying the groundwork to train one million farmers and build a nation of hope, resilience, and self-sufficiency.



### Guatemala – Hope & Healing in Nebaj 💚

Through the leadership of Dr. Juan Pablo and Carolina Noriega, the hospital provides essential medical care. Thanks to donor support, the hospital recently acquired a brand-new X-ray machine, dramatically improving the ability to diagnose and treat patients with accuracy and speed. Alongside essential medical care, initiatives like the Hebron School and Threads of Hope are equipping children and women with education and practical skills to build a better future. From life-saving blood transfusions to home visits and food packages, every act of care is made possible by the generosity of our donors.



## KEDHAP – Empowering Girls, Transforming Communities



In Kenya, the KEDHAP Foundation continues to be a beacon of hope, serving vulnerable communities through health, education, and empowerment initiatives across Kisumu and Nandi Counties. This month, the team empowered 739 girls through mentorship and menstrual hygiene support on World Menstrual Hygiene Day and provided financial literacy training to women in self-help groups. Their peace campaigns during the Kenya Sugar Board elections were recognized by national authorities, reflecting their deep-rooted commitment to reconciliation and unity.

## Peru – Shelter and Support at Hogar Genesis



Beyond the children's home that cares for 17 girls, the ministry reaches into the heart of the flood-prone community of Belen through weekly outreach programs that provide meals, Bible teaching, and school support for up to 80 children. A growing barber shop social enterprise also equips young people with skills while generating income to sustain the ministry. Plans are in progress for the construction of a permanent school for the children of Belen. The land has been purchased and the first four foundation columns have already been raised.

Despite the intense challenges in Haiti—including widespread violence and economic instability—Vision of Grace School continues to be a source of hope for 94 children in Fort-Jacques. Led by Principal Marie Estelle, the school offers daily education, prayer, and a sense of safety amid chaos. Your generous support has helped provide meals, salaries, and classroom materials, giving children not only the chance to learn, but also to heal from the trauma they face.
