# GIVE THE GIFT OF EDUCATION & LEADERSHIP TRAINING

#### Rood-Kelly dreams of becoming an engineer.

Rood-Kelly lost his mother when he was just two. When Vision of Grace opened in 2016, his grandfather wanted him to attend, but finances were always a barrier. Through a scholarship, he was able to join the school. Though at times he struggled with motivation, with encouragement from his teachers he has grown tremendously.



Education is a gateway to hope in Haiti, Kenya, Guatemala, Peru and Malawi. Your gift can provide school supplies, uniforms, and scholarships, opening doors to opportunities for children who otherwise might not have access to schooling.

### Equip future leaders with practical skills.

Pastors like Mumba from Chisamba are faithful leaders who serve their congregations despite financial hardship and limited access to training. Through The Grace Project Training Center, they now have the opportunity to receive high-quality theological and leadership education.



In Zambia, Cuba and India, we are equipping future leaders through theological training and community leadership programs. By investing in leadership, you're helping to shape communities grounded in faith and service.

Children like Berlina are a reminder of why this ministry matters so much. She joined our school after her family was displaced by the earthquake in the south of Haiti. At first, her caregivers weren't sure if she would thrive in school, as she often seemed distracted. But with the love and patience of her teacher, Berlina is now doing well in Grade 2 and growing in confidence every day. The daily meal at the school canteen has also played a big role in helping her focus and learn. (impacthope.ca/haitieducation)



In the heart of the Amazon region lies Iquitos — a place of vibrant culture but also deep poverty, where many children grow up surrounded by risk and instability. Through Hogar Génesis and the Belén Kids Ministry, lives are being transformed as hope replaces fear and love replaces neglect.

At Hogar Génesis, abandoned and at-risk girls find safety, care, and the chance to dream again. Within this home, they receive nutritious meals, education, counselling, and mentorship — essentials that nurture both their bodies and hearts. Every smile tells a story of healing, as girls once forgotten discover they are deeply valued.

Meanwhile, in the flood-prone slums of Belén, Rodolfo Córdova and his team reach more than 100 children every Saturday through the Belén Kids Ministry. These children, many living in harsh conditions, gather for meals, tutoring, and Bible teaching — a moment of stability in an otherwise uncertain world. Each week, their laughter fills the streets, a powerful reminder that hope can flourish even in the hardest places.

To ensure long-term sustainability, Rodolfo and his team are establishing a community barbershop — a small business designed to generate ongoing income to support the ministry. This initiative is expected to bring in at least \$1,500 CAD per month, helping offset operational costs and build a more stable future for the programs.

## IMPACT STORY: HEALTHCARE IN NEBAJ

When Doña Ester Chivalan walked into the Vida y Esperanza Hospital, she carried not just her own pain, but the worries of a struggling family. Her family's resources were nearly gone, and every medical bill felt impossible to pay. But thanks to the generosity of donors like you, Doña Ester received the care she desperately needed—her laboratory consultations were covered, and even the medications she required were provided free of charge.

With tears in her eyes, she shared her gratitude, saying that without this support, her family would not have been able to afford treatment. Today, she is recovering well and full of hope—living proof that compassion truly heals.

Every month, the hospital in Nebaj serves hundreds of patients just like Doña Ester. In 2025 alone, more than 3,900 patients have received consultations, 237 emergency cases have been treated, and over 800 ultrasounds and 470 X-rays have been performed—thanks to the new equipment provided through donor support.

#### Equip the most vulnerable for success.

At Hebron Vida y Esperanza School in Guatemala, Carolina leads a group of energetic students through their English lesson. Many of these children are sons and daughters of hospital staff — learning in an environment that values both education and faith. Empowerment begins with opportunity, and your gift helps make that possible.



Your support can empower educators to shape young minds and inspire lifelong learning. Providing school girls in Kenya with reusable sanitary pads, ensures they no longer miss school due to their periods.

Meet Princessa, a widow with new hope for the future. Once struggling to provide for her family, Princessa's life changed through the goat project in Malawi. Her small herd has grown to 11 goats, giving her the means to sell a few when she needs money for food or essentials. With fresh milk to nourish her children and goat manure enriching her maize field, her last harvest doubled — producing 18 bags of maize! Today, Princessa proudly stands as a hunger-free widow in a region often affected by drought and scarcity.

# IMPACT STORY: SOWING SEEDS OF CHANGE

In Madagascar, hundreds of farmers are discovering new hope through the Pfumvudza method—a climate-smart farming technique that is transforming lives and landscapes. Through the efforts of PPC Madagascar, six demonstration sites and Farmer Field Schools have been established across six provinces, reaching 1,359 farmers this year alone.

These sites serve as hands-on classrooms, where participants learn how to prepare, plant, and manage their fields to achieve higher yields even in the face of erratic rainfall and poor soil conditions. The results have been remarkable—rice production has risen from 5.2 to 6 tons per hectare, and maize yields increased from 4.76 to 4.93 tons per hectare in 2025.

"I was motivated by the training provided by PPC Madagascar in 2023 with the goal of becoming a young entrepreneur," shares Radotiana, one of the program participants. "Over two years, our maize and vegetable production has continued to increase beyond our expectations. Despite climate challenges, we're now planning to move into processing and work with other local farmers."

#### Sow seeds of change.

In the fertile lands of Madagascar, farmers once struggled with poor harvests and depleted soil. Today, through farmer field schools, they're learning sustainable techniques that triple their yields and restore the earth. By investing in this training, you help create real economic opportunities, enabling families to thrive and achieve long-term food security.



In Kenya, Malawi, Zambia, Madagascar, and Niger, your gift can support sustainable farming projects that help families grow their own food and create income. In Kenya, Malawi, and India, your support equips women with the they need to start their own businesses, resources independence, and contribute to their local economies. When women are given the opportunity to start their own businesses, they gain independence, create jobs, and reinvest in their local economies.

In the rural communities of Homa Bay County, many widows and vulnerable women face immense hardship after losing their source of income. This was Mary Owaka's reality after her husband passed away during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Everything changed when Mary joined the Shelter of Hope Women's Group. Through this empowering community, she received a sheep to start her own small livestock project and training in entrepreneurship, kitchen gardening, and basket making. The group also introduced table banking, enabling members to save and access small loans to grow their businesses.

"The benefits I've gained from the group are countless," Mary shares joyfully. "When I joined, I was given one sheep. Now I have six! I can pay my children's school fees and provide for their needs. I no longer feel lonely."

> Mary's story is a beautiful reminder that with opportunity, training, and community, women can rise above poverty and build a better future for their families.
