

RECENT UPDATES FROM THE GRACE PROJECT

LUSAKA, ZAMBIA, OCTOBER 2025

Empowering Pastors, Strengthening Communities

The Grace Project Training Center (TGPTC) continues its mission to equip pastors and Christian leaders in Zambia with the theological and practical skills needed to transform their communities. Despite personal and ministry challenges, the team remains steadfast in advancing the vision of making biblical training accessible to all – especially those in low-income and rural regions.

This month, the focus has been on expanding opportunities for pastors at every level. TGPTC is introducing three tiers of study to ensure that no pastor is left behind due to financial limitations:

- Distance/Online Learning: For working students
- Satellite Learning: For lower-income pastors in Lusaka’s densely populated areas
- Rural Outreach: For pastors serving in remote villages

This structure will allow the institute to meet pastors where they are – both geographically and financially – as it continues to nurture leaders who bring hope and transformation to their communities.



Praise Points

- **Satellite Growth:** TGPTC successfully reopened two satellite campuses in Mtendere East and George Compound and launched a brand-new satellite in Bauleni Compound. Together, these three centers represent 25 potential new students, ready to begin classes on October 20, 2025.
- **Rural Outreach Expansion:** Preparations are underway for new rural training programs in Miswa, Chisamba, Solwezi, Chingola, and Mfuwe. Local trained pastors in each community have already been identified to lead and supervise classes.
- **Radio Ministry Impact:** Weekly programs on Radio Christian Voice and One Love Radio have tackled theological topics and boosted public awareness of TGPTC’s ministry. These broadcasts have resulted in hundreds of inquiries from individuals eager to enroll or learn more about the institute.



TGPTC is expanding into five new rural areas—making biblical education accessible like never before.
