Madagascar – Growth, Resilience, and Real Impact

We're encouraged to share the latest update from Madagascar! In just the first quarter of 2026, 1,329 farmers were trained, and the program has now expanded to 15 regions across the country.

The results are powerful—farmers are seeing significantly higher yields, improving food security, and building more stable futures for their families. But beyond the numbers, it's the stories of renewed hope, confidence, and community transformation that truly stand out.

Guatemala – Hope & Healing in Nebaj

In Nebaj, Guatemala, the hospital continues to be a vital source of care for families across the region, with growing demand for both routine and critical services. Recent improvements—including completed electrical work and flooring in the new Operating Room area—are helping strengthen the hospital's capacity, while efforts are now focused on equipping key spaces and upgrading essential infrastructure like the medical oxygen system. At the same time, the dedicated local team continues to respond to urgent cases, provide life-saving treatment.



KEDHAP – Empowering & Equipping The Vulnerable

The Kenya Economic Development & Human Advancement Project (KEDHAP) continues to make strong progress across its core areas of education, health, and economic empowerment, despite increasing challenges in the region. Key achievements include sustained school attendance through fee payments, improved academic performance via enhanced monitoring, expanded community training programs for financial stability, and ongoing support for people living with HIV/AIDS, leading to better health outcomes.

Shelter of Hope – Education and Community Growth

Shelter of Hope continues to see meaningful growth across its programs, with over 350 children now enrolled in its schools and strong academic progress reported—culminating in top regional performance in recent national exams. The feeding program remains a cornerstone of the ministry, supporting both student retention and improved learning outcomes, while new infrastructure developments, including the construction of a girls' hostel, are underway to expand capacity.

Peru – Shelter and Support at Hogar Genesis

The team continues to provide a safe and loving home for 16 girls, ensuring they receive consistent care, meals, and education. A recent highlight is the successful preparation of an additional living space to meet government requirements, allowing the girls to remain together in a stable environment. The team also ministers on the streets of Belen & in the local prison.

Fernanda's Story Of Healing

Six-year-old Luz María loves math. If you visited Hogar Génesis in Iquitos, you might find her sitting at a small table with a pencil in hand, carefully working through numbers with a proud smile. She dreams of becoming a doctor one day – a big dream for a little girl.

She came from a difficult and unsafe environment where stability, good nutrition, and regular schooling were uncertain. Today, she is thriving in a place where she is safe, encouraged, and deeply loved.

Haiti – Faithful Ministry Amid Crisis

The school in Fort Jacques, Haiti, continues to operate faithfully despite ongoing instability and rising food costs. Today, 135 students are attending regularly, receiving both education and a daily meal—often their only reliable source of nutrition. While the surrounding situation remains challenging, the school has become a place of stability, prayer, and hope for children and families. Continued support is essential to sustain meals, pay teachers, and ensure these children can keep learning in a safe environment.

Lives Protected, More Help Needed in Malawi

In Malawi, the Safe Water Project continues to protect vulnerable communities from cholera and other waterborne diseases. In a recent outreach at Katsekaminga, 364 households received hygiene education and monthly water purification supplies, helping families access safe drinking water. While this progress is encouraging, the need remains urgent as the outbreak continues to spread, highlighting the importance of expanding both immediate support and long-term solutions like boreholes.
